

Aloha e nā 'ohana o Kanu o ka 'Āina,

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) provides the parent(s)/guardian(s) of a public school student the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom kumu and if the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications. Federal law allows you to ask for specific information about your child's classroom kumu and paraprofessional(s). It requires us to give you this information promptly upon request.

You have the right to ask for the following information about each of your child's classroom kumu.

- 1. Whether the kumu has met state qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which they provide instruction.
- 2. Whether the kumu is teaching under emergency or another provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived.
- 3. Whether the kumu is teaching in the field of discipline of their certification.
- 4. Whether any educational assistant provides services to your child and, if they do, their qualifications.
